## General information and rules.

1. Held under OBRA permit. All OBRA Cyclocross rules are in force.
2. All competitors must wear approved helmets.
3. Some classes will be started together, but scored separately.
4. Registration opens at 8:30am on race day & closes 15 minutes before the start of each race.
5. All riders under 18 will need parent's or guardian's signature on a release form.
6. Early registration prior to race day is possible at Cycle Analysis, Tues-Sat 10-5.
7. No late fee for registration on race day.

## 8. All Checks payable to Josephine County Search and Rescue.

9. No refunds due to inclement weather, after all, this is cyclocross.
  10. Mountain bikes are welcome as well as traditional cyclocross bikes.
