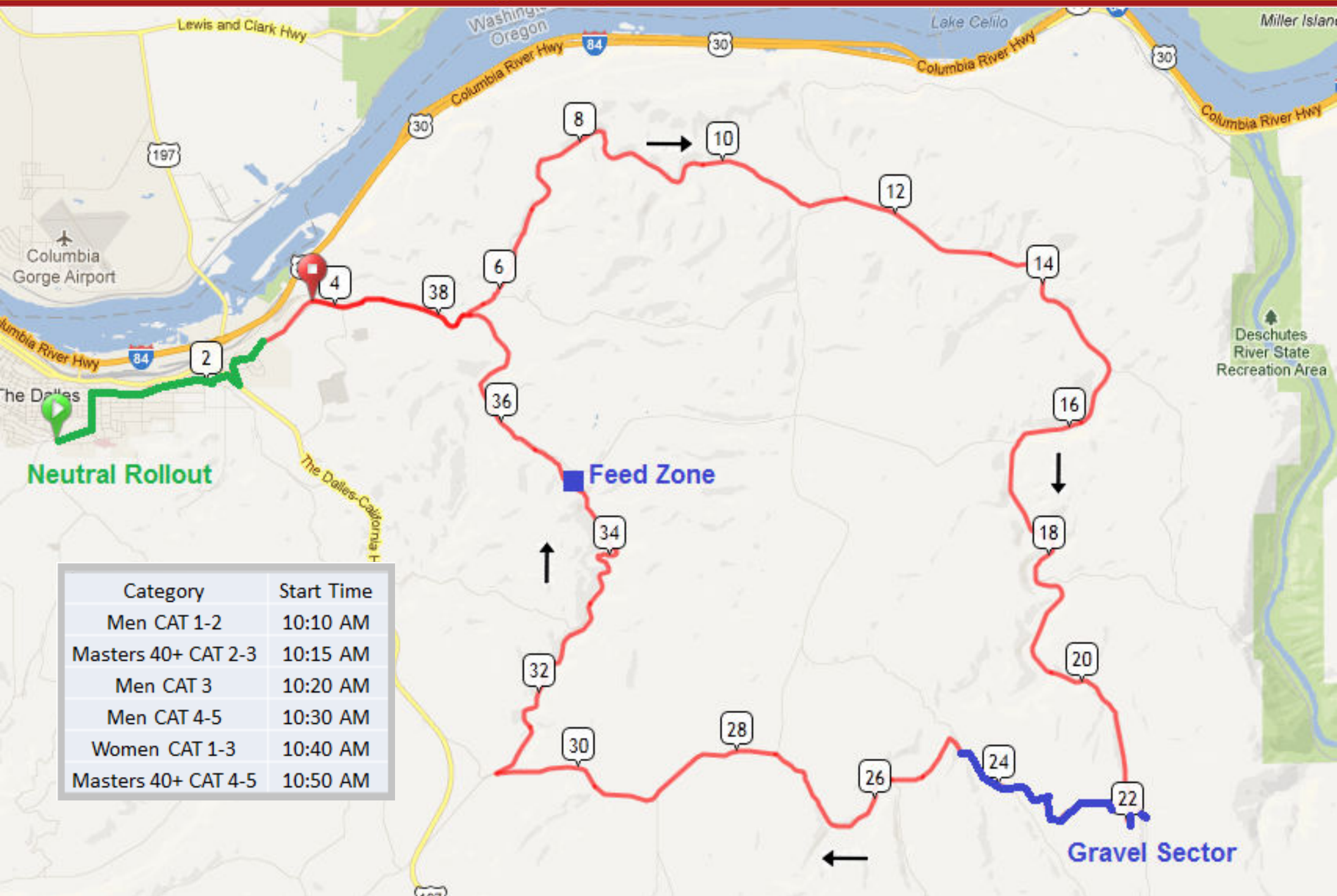

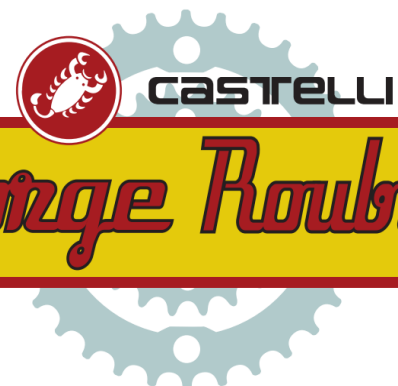

## Course Description

Race course is a mix of good-moderate asphalt and solid gravel roads. Climbs are moderate an 11-23 gear will suffice.

## Race Support

Each field will have one follow vehicle with neutral wheels available. Wheels will be limited and it is strongly suggested you donate to your categories supply. That said everyone should carry a spare inflation cartridge and tube. You will be riding on gravel so choose your tire and tube selection wisely!!! There is a feed zone on course but you are responsible to bring the feeders. No neutral bottles will be supplied at the feed zone.

## Neutral Rollout and Return

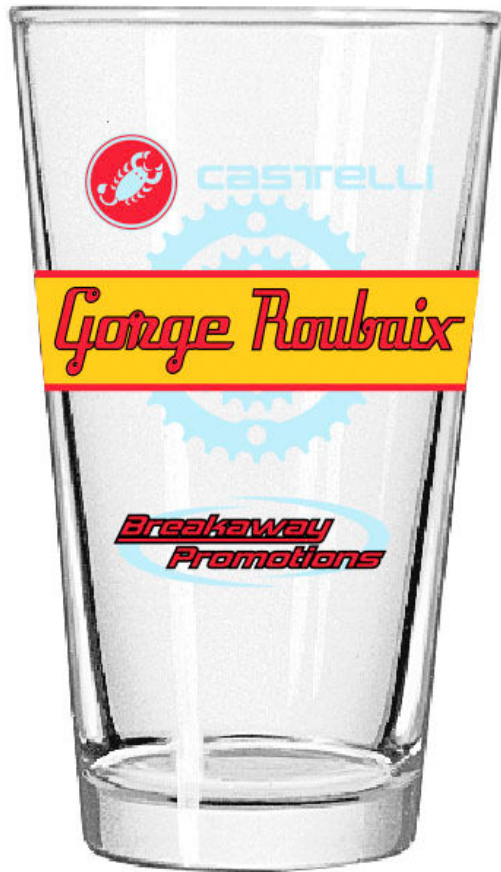
Race will remain neutral for the first 3 miles until safely out of town. Should you pass the lead vehicle or attack you will be DQed. Enough said. Once you are finished with your race there is a 3 mile roll back to the start line. Be prepared and do not whine. It gives you a chance to flush the legs. Friends and loved ones wanting to watch the finish are able to drive to the finish line and park alongside the road just West of the finish. There is absolutely no parking in any of the driveways along Columbia View Heights. That land is owned by Bonneville Power and is considered a national security risk for parking on their land.
