



**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Race will stage at Santiam Christian High School in Adair Village, OR. (See directions, below). Spare wheels will be “Neutral” for this event (wheels you bring may be issued to another rider in the event of a puncture during the race). Return ALL spare wheels issued to you to the Wheel Pit!!

**PARKING**

Park at Santiam Christian High School, in Adair County Park, or along Arnold Avenue. Follow signs and directions given by Event Volunteers. **DO NOT** park in the Valley Catering, Prince of Peace Church or private parking lots/driveways! Unauthorized vehicles parked here will be towed.

**COURSE DESCRIPTION**

See the Course Map and Profile on-line. There will be a neutral roll-out from the staging area at Santiam Christian to Independence Hwy. Once you turn left (north) onto Independence Hwy, racing will commence. Fields will do one or two laps (~25 mi ea). The course includes smooth pavement which rolls through the hills north of Corvallis & Albany. There are a few 90-degree turns, some short rollers and significant flat stretches to test your early season legs and tactics. The finish is uphill on NW Palestine Ave.

## PRIZES

- Afternoon Session Prizes to be presented after the end of the last races as soon as Results are tabulated.
- \* Prizes shown are estimates, based on percentage of gross proceeds, and may vary with race participation.

## FACILITIES

Portable toilets are available at Registration and at the Finish Line. Water will be available in Coolers & Jugs at the Information Area and at the Starting Area.

## SPECIAL INFORMATION

- Use **your** OBRA Race Numbers for this event. Pin **two** numbers on your jersey – one on your **right side** and one **horizontally across your back**. If Officials cannot read your number, you will not be scored. **OBRA licenses** are required to race. Licenses will be available for purchase at the Registration Area. No license = No race. We **STRONGLY** urge racers to get their license from OBRA **as early as possible**.
- Riders off-the-back and Returning to the Start Area **must** follow Oregon Rules of the Road and all applicable traffic laws and signing. **Ride single file and check for traffic regularly**.
- Centerline Rule will be enforced for **your safety!** Officials will relegate or DQ centerline violators at will. This is your First and Final Warning. Helmets required anytime you are on your bike.
- Littering and public urination will **not be tolerated** and subject to **fine and/or prosecution**.
- **Rail Road Tracks** cross the NEUTRAL portion of the Start. If a train approaches, the field will wait!
- No feed zones. Feeding from vehicles or spectators is not allowed at anytime.
- OBRA and the Race Promoters do not provide insurance coverage for injuries that occur at the race. Costs related to any injuries are the responsibility of the individual participant.
- **Participation in the Cherry Pie Road Race is voluntary. Race Promoters are not responsible for personal injury, loss or damage of equipment, or theft directly or indirectly related to your voluntary participation in this event.**

## DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM:

- **Monmouth (Hwy 99W):** Drive south on 99W for 30 miles. In Adair Village, turn left (east) on NE Arnold. Santiam Christian HS approx. ½ mile ahead on right.
- **Corvallis (Hwy 99W):** From downtown Corvallis (99W & Hwy 20), head north on 99W for 8.4 miles. In Adair Village, turn right (east) on NE Arnold. Santiam Christian HS approx. ½ mile ahead on right.
- **Portland (I-5 southbound):** Drive south on I-5 to Albany. Take Exit 234A west. Follow Hwy 20 west towards Corvallis. 4 miles after crossing the Willamette river (leaving Albany), turn right (north) onto Independence Hwy. In 2.4 miles, turn left (west) onto Ryals Ave. Watch for bikes! You are now on the course. Ryals Ave becomes NE Arnold in Adair Village. From I-5 to Santiam Christian HS: 27 miles.
- **Eugene (I-5 northbound):** Drive north on I-5 to Albany. Take Exit 233/Hwy 20 west. In Albany, follow directions above for *I-5 south bound*. I-5 to Santiam Christian HS: 27 miles.
