Description: The Outdoor City Gravel Grinder packs more views and diverse roads into a short amount of distance than any gravel grinder in North America. Ride starts at the base of Mt. Bachelor before heading west and then north high up into the Cascade Mountain Range. Ascend the legendary Forest Service Road 370 up over the flanks of Broken Top and South Sister. The ride tops out at 7000 feet of elevation before descending down into the Tumalo Creek drainage. Then it is the long climb back up to Mt. Bachelor where the party will be kicking off. Ride entry fee includes a shirt, beer, pint glass and lunch. The ride will be chipped timed with awards for the top three in each category.
